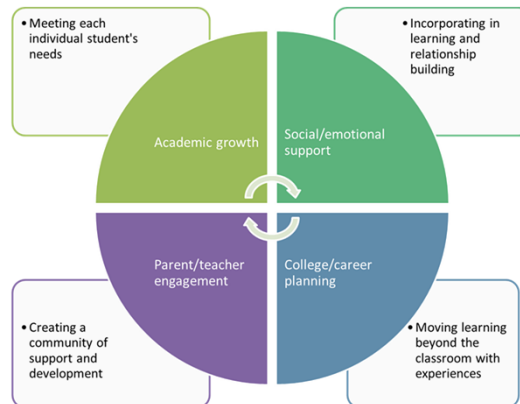
WHAT
