## UW Robinson Center for Young Scholars

*Please note that due to COVID-19, Robinson Center Enrichment is currently offering courses both online and on campus but is not offering hybrid courses. Any changes will be communicated with families and updated on our website in a timely manner.*

### Saturday Program

#### GRADES K-8

Saturday classes are intended to provide intellectually ambitious students with challenge, inspiration, and fun, in a collaborative, supportive learning environment. Our classes are not intended to move students ahead in the standard curriculum but rather to explore topics not usually covered in the K-8 classroom, including chess, philosophy, architecture, and more.

- Each class session is 50 minutes and meets over a period of 8 Saturdays each quarter. Our schedule allows students to take up to 3 classes a quarter.
- Tuition per class: \$275, which includes **non-refundable** \$25 registration fee. Tuition is waived for students qualifying for Free/Reduced Lunch.
- There are no qualification requirements for Saturday programs.

#### GRADES 5-6

Summer Challenge is an academically advanced summer program for children who will have completed the 5th or 6th grade. Summer Challenge provides motivated students with an intensive, hands-on, fun, and educational experience in areas outside of the traditional school curriculum.

- The program runs for three weeks, five days a week, 9:00am–2:20pm. The Robinson Center offers before-class and after-class care when in person.

#### GRADES 7-10

*(Not all classes are open to all grade levels.)*

Summer Stretch offers both accelerated courses (e.g. Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Precalculus, Chemistry) and courses for enrichment (e.g. American Literature, Speech and Debate, Physics of Robotics). All of these courses provide an in-depth, intensive learning experience.

- The 2021 program will run for four weeks, four days a week (Mon-Thurs), 9:00am–2:20pm.
- Tuition: \$1,200 including a **non-refundable** \$50 registration fee. Tuition assistance is available for students qualifying for Free/Reduced Lunch.
