



Robinson Center for Young Scholars 2023-24 Saturday Parking & Transportation Guide

ON-CAMPUS PARKING

Cost: Lots have different costs depending on location. Many campus parking lots are self-serve, allowing you to skip the gatehouse and pay on the spot. Some have pay machines where you enter your stall or license plate number.

We strongly recommend downloading the [PayByPhone app](#) before coming to campus on Saturday, as for many lots on weekends it is the only way to pay for parking.

The Central Parking Garage is the closest and has several levels of parking. Central Garage is located under Red Square and can be accessed most easily from 15th Ave NE just north of the Henry Art Gallery.

The closest accessible parking is also in the Central Parking Garage. [Accessible parking](#) is available in other lots throughout the campus as well.

We recommend that you visit the University of Washington's online map to locate Mary Gates Hall and the Robinson Center (listed on the map as the Guggenheim Annex). [The map can be found here.](#)

STREET PARKING

COST: .50 - \$5 per hour

Most University District parking is .50/hour until 11am, after which it increases to \$5/hour east of 12th Ave NE. If you prefer to utilize street parking, please be aware that University District parking is not free on Saturdays and parking can be a challenge, so allot extra time to find a spot.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

COST: Free for youth, \$3.00 for adults

[Google Maps](#) is the best resource for looking up bus routes that take you to campus. You can type in Mary Gates Hall and Google Maps will find the correct building. You can also visit [Metro Trip Planner](#) or [Sound Transit Trip Planner](#) for bus and light rail schedules. Schedules DO vary on weekends, so make sure you are looking at search results for Saturday rather than a weekday. OneBusAway is the best real-time bus tracking app for the region.

UW SPORTS AND OTHER UNIVERSITY DISTRICT EVENTS

Check the [UW Football calendar](#) so that you can be aware of days when campus will be particularly busy. We strongly recommend taking Link Light Rail and/or planning alternate routes on these dates as traffic and parking will be more challenging on these days.

The University District Farmers Market runs every Saturday from 9am-2pm on University Way NE between NE 50th & NE 52nd Streets.
